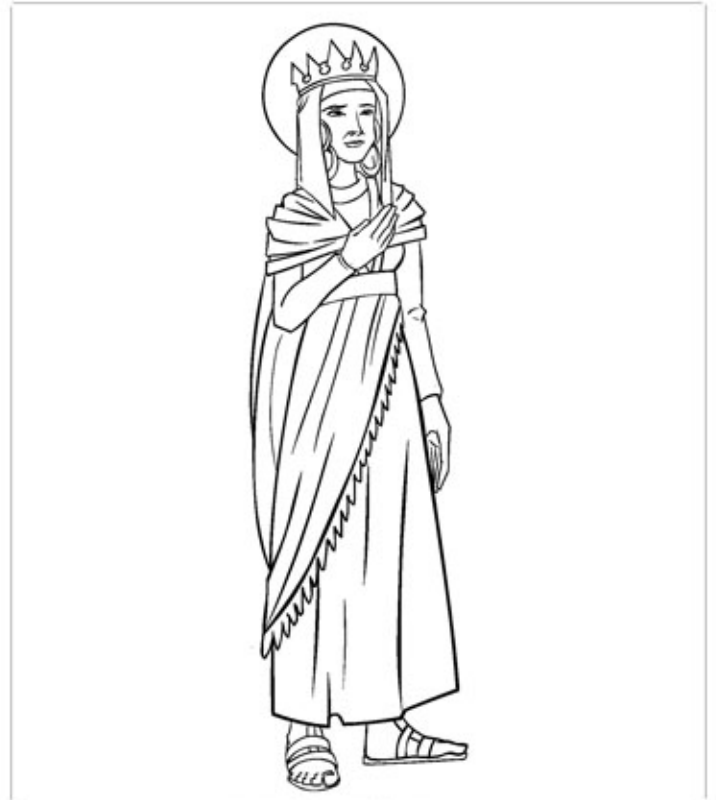

St. Helena of the Cross



St. Helena of the Cross

Appropriate for:
Preschool, Grade K

Stained-Glass Shrine

- Supplies**
- Empty Crystal Light Cans (one can makes 2 shrines)
 - Colored permanent markers
 - Glue
 - Small cups
 - Plastic paint brushes
 - Picture of St. Helena of the Cross
 - Scissors
 - Paper towels
 - Optional: newspaper

- Set Up**
1. Fill small paper cups with glue $\frac{1}{4}$ of the way full. Place paint brush in cup.
 2. Place newspaper at each child's work area.
 3. Pre-cut Crystal Light cans with pattern (page 28). Put one shrine for each child along with a picture of St. Helena, pre-cut in an arch shape in each child's work space.
 4. Place colored markers in center of table so children can share.

- Directions**
1. Glue picture of St. Helena of the Cross on the front center of Shrine. This will be the outside of the can.
 2. Wipe any excess glue off of shrine. Glue will impair permanent markers.
 3. Color with permanent markers various colors and shapes making the image of a stained-glass frame around the picture. The teacher may wish to divide the frame with lines for the children to color between if the group is too young to make their own designs successfully.
